For parents that do not have internet access, please phone the school on 63 520 200 after the 15th of June and discuss the approximate times required. Interviews are strictly 10 minutes. If you require more time, please contact your teacher directly to make alternative arrangements.

Please note that 24 hours' notice must be given to change or add an appointment.


